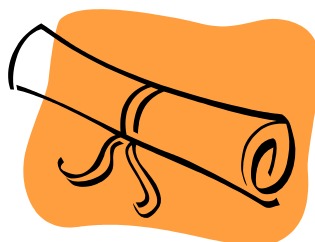
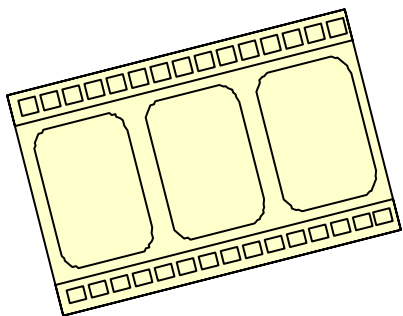


# Senior Recognition
